提高香港老年隊的成績(二)

去年，我們參加在上海舉行的世界錦標賽，確實是倉促成軍，事前一點思想準備都沒有，從知道可以去上海，到成行那一天，一共只有三天時間。大家都知道，我們這6個人的基本功，都是一般水平，再加上有二對選手，從未在一起打過牌，所以未寄望過有意想不到的成績（只有一場以20:10勝中國隊，有點意外 ----- 他們出場的有三位世界級的大師，恰好第四位沒有經驗，犯了許多不該犯的錯誤，才導致失敗）。但卻有許多意想不到的錯誤，有許多錯誤，即使初學者，都已經學過，不知怎樣，我們大家打了幾十年的牌，卻不斷出現這些初學者的錯誤。下面我就舉些實戰中的牌例，目的是希望將來這些錯誤盡量少犯。

(I) 雙方的約定，只知其然，不知其所以然。

例如，對波蘭隊，無局對有局，你是北，第三家，持

擦肩而過 (論中美二國女子橋牌隊的半決賽)

中美二國女子隊在去年 10 月的威尼斯盃的半決賽中相遇, 引起大家的關注. 這場比賽, 說成冠軍的前哨戰, 也不為過. 中國在本土比賽, 爲了贏得這場比賽, 做了極其充分的準備. 最後選定出場的六位隊員, 都是經驗豐富, 久經沙場的老將. 我不知道, 經過七天的初賽, 體力上是否消耗過度, 或者人民對她們期望的壓力是否太大, 以致影響她們的正常表演, 這些不在我的論述範圍. 從另一個角度, 橋牌比賽是比誰的失誤少的比賽, 從我來看雙方都有一些失誤, 而這些失誤, 有些在平時不可能犯錯, 卻在比賽中表現出來, 這是非常可惜的. 比賽的每節比分, 都非常接近, 以致到最後一副牌, 美國隊員當時並不知道已經領先 9 IMP, 否則在第 96 副牌上, 她叫 3NT 被加倍時, 完全可以改到 4♣. 即使被加倍, 防守方不出錯牌, 也只有二下, 可以確保勝利. 而 3NT 被加倍, 可以下四, 形勢就會完全逆轉.

(I) 第一個問題, 首攻不準, 也就是聽完叫牌, 對整體牌的描述不夠, 以致第一墩牌常常不能擊中要害, 請看:

北家首攻, 應該仔細回想叫牌東的 4♣是建議以♥爲將牌的滿貫興趣. 西同意進軍滿貫, 扣叫♠, 這是東最願意聽到的. 東能衝上大滿貫, 表示除♥外, 有齊三張 A. 除低花 2 個 A 外, ♠和♥必能拿到 11 墩, ♠必爲 6 張, ♥可能只有一二張. 唯一的問題, 你拿著二個低花 K, 有 4 張將牌, 萬一有將牌阻塞, 例如同伴有♥J, 明手♥10x 或同伴♥10x, 明手單♥J. 她怎麼回手調將. 西的 5♠叫牌已告訴你她有♥AKQ, 還有♠K (從扣叫 4♠看), 她如有♥10 或♥J, 已是鐵牌, 所以你要首攻♠J. 希望同伴拿

著♥J或♥10x, 從叫牌看, 即使萬一要飛低花K, 也一定飛中. 實戰首攻將牌, 送掉大滿貫. 另一桌叫牌:

叫得比較保守. 美國女隊坐北首攻♠J, 只能拿到 12 墩, 輸 17 IMP. 如果打宕 7♥, 就算閉室未叫到 6♥, 也勝(+100+680) 13 IMP. 來回相差 30 IMP. 這副牌即使閉室叫到 7♥, 如仍首攻 J, 那將輸得更多, 所以只有首攻♠J 才能立於不敗之地. 這副牌的最佳合約是 7♠或 7NT, 但在公開組凡叫到 7♠的都沒有打成.

首攻♣J, 莊家連打3墩♦, 東西均墊♣. 第5墩從明手出♠10, 依次為♠Q, K, A. 回出♠下一. 其實這副牌, 北提6墩♦, 2墩♣後, 剩5張時, 留意東西的墊牌, 如你判斷準, 是可以打成的. 例如你剩下的5張牌是♠K9 ♥J4 ♣Q, 東最厲害是剩♠A5 ♥Q ♣108. 看到明手的♥, 她能這樣留牌嗎?除此之外, 你都能完成合約. 這種細節我們不討論了.

(II) 叫牌問題

要一個隊員, 每副牌都叫到恰似其份, 大概是不可能的. 有時高叫或低叫 (或許為某種原因), 但有些牌, 卻是明顯高叫(或低叫).

張, 加叫 5♣. 中國女隊開叫 3♣全 pass. 西的牌是:
