

The last set in the qualifying round was probably the most exciting finale in the history of the Inter-city. In Section A, China Resources clinched top spot when Shenzhen Topone was upset by the 9^{th} -placed team. However, they both qualified. In Section B, Ambassador beat the top-placed team and came from behind to finish 1^{st} in the section. Full Moon needed only 17 VPs to qualify while Shenyang Shengyutian required 25 to have any chance. Alas, Full Moon managed only 16 while Shenyang scored 25 and qualified with a higher IMP quotient on tie-breaking. In Section C, Kuncheng topped the section with 199 VPs. AlA clinched 2^{nd} spot with a 25-VP win in the last round. Section D was probably the most exciting. 4 teams were fighting it out in the last round. It was Shanghai Yangpu and Guangdong Zhongshan Jiegao who triumphed at the end with a small margin. In the Youth (Y) Section, HKU came on top with 173 VPs, CUHK, SL3NT and Little Mummichog rounded out the qualifying spots.

The draw for the match-ups will be in the Luxembourg Room at 9:30 this morning.



This hand illustrates the characteristics of a 2-suiter overcall. You will play in one of your suits, and you do not want partner to play in other strains.

The hand belongs to your side or you can be sure of a sacrifice. Partner can locate a fit with 3 cards in one of your suit. It would be wrong for South to pass or double in this example. All three characteristics are important, because the 2-suiter overcall is no small toy.

North leads a club to the Queen and Ace.

Liszt plays the top spades to find North with the [QT. Now he has a potential loser in each suit, and the communications are scanty.

He decides to look for an end play in trumps, so South must hold 4333. North must hold the red Aces, otherwise the end play will fail.

Therefore Liszt plays the {6, and North is welcome to play the {A. North produces the {8, so Liszt calls the {K from dummy. A second diamond goes to North, and now North does not like the idea of leading a heart. His only hope is for a club, but Liszt wins with the }T as dummy throws a diamond.

The]K goes to the]A, and dummy discards another diamond on the third club. Now Liszt takes the]Q, ruffs a heart, and plays the last diamond from dummy.

South has to follow and give the last 2 tricks to dummy.


