2. Matters Arising from Minutes of the Last Meeting

- --The Ladies Team representing Hong Kong in the World Team Olympiad in Greece will reimburse the Association their entry fee before the end of December.
- -- AC, instead of SS, will draft an article for publication in Bridgzette re-emphasizing the importance of properly filled-up convention cards.
- -- It appears that the incident where a player was found to have wrongly claimed hand and made remark before the bidding ended

took place during the final session of Open Team of Four, rather than Inter-city Trial. Anyway, AC will obtain statement from Benjamin Kwok direct before agreeing the AC facts with the responsible tournament director.

-- JM has not checked with the Amateur Sports Federation & Olympic Committee JM of Hong Kong the procedures to upgrade the Association's status in their organisation to full membership as per WBF's request for so doing.

-- SW has not contacted Shirley Ieong to see whether the latter will be SW willing to assist in arranging partner for overseas visitors. SW will then SW update Hong Kong Tourist Association our contact accordingly.

3. Progress on PABF Championship 1997

Roger Ling's and Ashley Lung's team have entered into the play-off stage for the selection of the Open Team. The 6 sessions will finish before end of this year.

4. Questionnaire to Members
In order to publish the results before the next AGM, the findings analyzed by IM will be discussed in the Council Meeting held in

- 6. Open League Unannounced Absence of Tom Wong's Team
 DZ will obtain explanation and apology from the team captain, Tom
 Wong, on this incident. Further disciplinary action against Tom
 Wong's team will be decided later.

7. Availability of Venue

DZ will contact the responsible personnel of China Resources Group to see whether the latter may provide new venue for the Association. Regarding the Chinese Club, the Association has to book through their members. Although they only charge HK\$700 per session, they require the Association to guarantee minimum spending of HK\$4,500 on meals, failing which any deficiency will be added to the rental. It was resolved that for tournaments held in the Chinese Club in future, in addition to normal tournament fee, players have to pay HK\$40 more for cash coupon valid for that session only. SW and CC will design a system for the issuance and maintenance of cash

The existing lease between Little Flower Club and the Government will expire on 27/12/1996. For safety sake, the stationery and other materials will be moved out before that date. DZ will ask the management of Little Flower Club after 27/12/1996 to see whether the club premises will be available for our booking.

Chung Ngan Club prefers the Association to hold more events on Thursdays. DZ/AC will also check whether Mariner's Club would be available on Thursdays. Besides, AC will contact the Catholic priest, a Council member of Mariner's Club, for assistance in making bookings for the Association.

DZ will check with Shirley Chang to see whether the Jewish Recreation Club may DZ be made available to the Association. As suggested by Imran Gardezi, contact was provided by Shirley Chang for The Mughal, an Indian restaurant located in the junction between Windham Street and Hollywood Road in Central. AL will visit the venue and submit a report in the next council meeting.

3. Application for Grant from Sir David Trench Fund
JM has submitted the relative form to the Fund for approval of grant
and reply is expected within 3 months. Ms Portia Tam, Assistant
Staff Officer for Sports Promotion, Leisure Services Division of
Regional Council also suggested the Association to apply subsidy for
organising student bridge events from the SK/IL Urban
Council/Regional Council Subsidies for Sports Activities.

 The report amended by SK was read and adopted.

10. A.O.B.

a.AC has finalised the tournament schedule for the quarter ended 31/3/1997. CY and CC will arrange for mailing to all members.

b. Although the accounts for this fiscal year have not been finalised, CC opined that no profit will be envisaged from regular tournaments. Subject to members' consent in the next AGM, with effect from 1/3/1997, tournament fee will be increased from HK\$60 to HK\$80 for members (half fee for senior and student members) and from HK\$100 to HK\$120 for non-members.

c. There has not been any increase in director's fee for a number of years. Subject to members' consent in the next AGM, with effect from 1/3/1997, the scale will be revised to HK\$400 (unchanged) plus HK\$40 (increased from HK\$30) per table for tables exceeding

DZ will consult Terence Tung on proper interpretion of the conditions for special voting membership as listed out in the revised Handbook of the Association before the Council considers this in the next council meeting.

f.As preparation for the next AGM, JM will update the special voting member list before the next council meeting. Any addition or removal of special voting member will be discussed in the next council meeting. Notice will be sent to the last known address of any removed special voting member who may lodge his/her objection within 14 days.

g.Recently, the council has received 3 complaints on director's ruling or players' ethics. Complainants are reminded, if all possible, they should exercise their own right by first asking for director's ruling at the time where the incidence took place and subsequently lodge appeal if they consider an inappropriate ruling was made, rather than voicing their grievance in these kind of letters.

11. Date of Next Meeting

The next council meeting will be held in the conference room of Room 1902, Tower 6, China Hong Kong City on 16/1/1997. There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:50 p.m.

If none of these teams would like to represent Hong Kong in this tournament, interested members are welcome to form their own team, subject to Council's approval.

Alan Sze & Glenn Ho, Simon Wong & Daniel Chui, W.K. Lai & K.H. Sin and Patrick Yum & Lawrence Lo have qualified

from the Youth Team Selection Trial.

It was resolved that W.Y. Sit. Chris Chung and J.M. Shen will be the non-playing captain of the Open, Ladies and Youth Team respectively. Team captains are reminded to submit the names of their team members and their system notes to AC before 31/1/1997. Besides, the team captains have to submit their team's training schedule to the Council before 31/1/1997.

It was resolved that entry fee of HK\$3,000 will be refunded to the only Ladies Team enrolled for the Trial.

The V-U graph programme is being tested. However, no one has yet to agree to be the V-U graph commentator.

Some sponsorship letters have been sent through Stephen Kwok but nothing has been confirmed so far.

4. Questionnaire to Members

About 70 members have sent back their reply sheets. The findings will be analysed by JM before 20/1/1997.

The lease between Little Flower Club and the Government has been extended for one more year.

The new rental for each session at Mariner's Club is HK\$29,000 plus HK\$150 tips.

DZ will check with Shirley Chang to see whether the Jewish Recreation Club may be made available to the Association on Thursday nights.

Lawrence Lau has some suggestions on new venues. AC and AL will be responsible for contacting him for these new possibilities.

Robert Zajac has suggested a new venue in Taikoo Place, Quarry Bay which requires the Association to join their corporate membership for HK\$48,000 first (80% refundable). AL will inspect the place together with Robert Zajac some time next week and report in the next council meeting.

AL has visited The Mughal which is located at I/F., 75 Wyndham Street. It is opposite to Central Police Station and 7 to 8 minutes' walk from Central MTR station. At most 20 tables can be accommodated and both Chinese and Indian main courses can be offered at reasonable prices. Rental for HK\$2,000 will be charged for each evening session which runs from 6 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. Besides, closet will be provided free of charge to store our stationery and equipment. AC will schedule some tournaments there in March to see whether the venue worths more extensive use.

7. <u>Application for Subsidy from the Urban Council/Regional Council Subsidies for Sports Activities</u>

SK will follow up with IL on the application for subsidy from the Urban Council/ Regional Council Subsidies for Sports Activities to organise student bridge events in future.

8. <u>To add or remove any member(s) from Special Voting</u> Membership

但這副牌,中國隊過於進取,叫到 6NT ,這 6NT 是根本無成功希望,除非東西的牌極特殊。例如:西家拿♣K10 雙張,東家拿◆Q 單張大牌,且有♠K ,才有可能成功,但如叫到 6H ,成功機會還較 6NT 大。只要東有♠K ,且♠分配不壞於 5-2 ,最好不要首攻◆,否則就一定要飛♣等等。總之,要求條件很多,故 6H 也不是好合約。

China bidded badly to 6NT and deservedly lost 12 IMPs when USA stopped safely in 4H. 6H must be a better contract even with agreesive tactics, standing some slam chance on a non-diamond lead, a friendly SK.

The Convention Card and Classification of Systems

by Anthony Ching

The Convention Card

According to the HKCBA Rules and Regulations, "All partnership must fill in a copy of the HKCBA Convention Card at any HKCBA tournament, failing which procedural penalties will be assessed". This is an authority granted under Law 40(E)1. This regulation has not been seriously enforced in the past. In the coming year, however, the Tournament Directors have been instructed by the Council to gradually put this into force.

First of all, what is a Convention Card. The Convention Card is a form designed by the NCBO (in this case the HKCBA) which allows a partnership to describe in a summary the conventions used and the agreements between the partners. These conventions and agreements may not otherwise be recognised by the opponents.

Secondly, what is the purpose of the Convention Card. Although the current alert procedures, if practised properly, provide adequate information at the table, it may be too late for the opponents to prepare a defence for it. The Convention Card gives the opponents the opportunity to know in advance what conventions are used by a partnership, in order to properly prepare a defence.

What, then, must be filled in? The principle is proper disclosure whose golden guideline, as described by the WBF, is to tell the opponents what you would like them to tell you in a similar circumstance. Since the purpose is to forewarn the opponents of any special agreements that you are using, there should be no surprises and ambiguities. For example, if you describe that you are using variable NT, you should only mean that you are playing weak NT when not vulnerable and strong NT when vulnerable. If your defensive jump overcalls are weak or intermediate, describe the conditions for each. If the Convention Card does not provide sufficient space to explain your agreements in details, you may either carry a supplementary sheet or alert your opponents prior to the start of the round. The HKCBA Convention Card has only sufficient space to cover the first, and in some cases the second, round of bidding, and you are only required to complete them as such. Note that the completion of the WBF Convention Card is not covered here. That is covered in the "Guide to Completion of the WBF Convention Card & Supplementary Sheet" published by the WBF.

If you fail to carry a Convention Card to a tournament, there are plenty of blank cards available at the venue. Unfortunately, the guidelines for completing the card is no longer in the HKCBA Handbook. If you have questions about filling in the card, ask the Tournament Director or other experienced players available. If you play without a Convention Card, the Tournament Directors have been instructed to take the following actions:

- If there is a difference between your verbal explanation and the actual hand, resulting in damage, the scores will be adjusted in favour of your opponents and a procedural penalty given to you.
- If there is a dispute regarding misinformation or forgetfulness by you, resulting in damage, the scores will be adjusted in favour of your opponents, and a procedural penalty given to you.
- If you cannot explain properly a bid which may be a convention or agreement, you will not be allowed to play that convention or agreement during that tournament whether or not it results in damage. Adjustment of scores may be necessary.
- 4. As the regulation is gradually enforced, you will be required to complete a Convention Card on the spot and be assessed a procedural penalty.

Classification of Systems

The HKCBA adopts the classifications described in the WBF Systems Policy.

Systems are classified into colours according to the following rules:

- 1. Green: Natural.
- 2. Blue: Strong Club/Strong Diamond, where one club/one diamond is always strong.
- 3. Red: Artificial: this category includes all artificial systems that do not fall underthe definition of Highly Unusual Methods (HUM) systems (see definition below), other than Strong Club/Strong Diamond systems.

Examples would be a system where one club shows one of three types - a natural club suit, a balanced hand of specific range, or a Strong Club opener; or a system in which the basic methods (other than the no-trump range) vary according to position, vulnerability and the like; or a system that uses conventional "weak" or multi-meaning" bids (with or without some weak option) in potentially contestable auctions, other than those described in the main part of the WBF Conventions Booklet.

4. Yellow: Highly Unusual Methods (HUM) as defined below.

For the purpose of the WBF Systems Policy, a Highly Unusual Methods (HUM) means any System that exhibits one or more of the following features, as a matter of partnership agreement:

- A. A Pass in the opening position promises the values generally accepted for an opening bid of one, and the player who passes will or may hold values a queen or more above average hand strength (i.e. an average hand contains 10 high card points).
- B. By partnership agreement, an opening bid at the one level may be weaker than pass.
- C. By partnership agreement, an opening bid at the one level be made with values a king or more below average strength.
- D. By partnership agreement, an opening bid at the one level shows either length or shortage in a specified suit; or either length in a specified suit or length elsewhere.

In addition, the WBF System Policy classified the following conventions or treatments as "Brown Sticker":

- 1. Any OPENING BID of two clubs through three spades, or a one- two- or three-level OVERCALL of a natural opening of one of a suit, that:
 - could be weak (may by agreement be made with value below average strength),

AND

- does not show at least four cards in a known suit. EXCEPTION:
- The bid always shows at least four cards in a known suit if it is weak. If the bid does not show a known four-card suit it must show a hand king or more over average strength.
- An opening bid showing a weak two in either major, whether with or without the option of strong hand types, as described in the WBF Conventions Booklet.
- An OVERCALL of a natural opening bid of one of a suit does not promise at least four cards in a known suit.

EXCEPTION: An overcall in no-trumps.

Any "weak" two-suiter bids at the two- or three-level that may by agreement be made with three cards or fewer in one of the suits.

None of the foregoing restrictions pertain to conventional defences against strong, artificial opening bids or defences against "Brown Sticker" conventions or HUM systems.
