1. The minutes of the last meeting prepared by AY was read and adopted with the following amendments:
 - 1.1 Para 2.1 "Someone had been employed by AC (under his own expenses)" should be replaced by "AC had got someone"
 - 1.2 Para 4.6 "on time" should read as "in time"
2. Matters arising from last minutes.
 - 2.1 9th All China National Games (Year 2000)
DZ would follow up for more details DZ
 - 2.2 Club Venue
AL, instead of C. Booth , would contact the landlord for his kindness to reduce the monthly rent. AL
3. Progress on Various Matters
 - 3.1 Intercity
There would be 16 local teams and 20 teams from overseas.
If there were no more overseas entries by 15 July. More local teams might be accepted to make up the total number of 40 teams.
The total sponsorship still amounted to HK\$236,000. CW
 - 3.2 Based on available records, the winner of TS Lo cup for 1997 should be Nelson Hsi.

4. A.O.B.

4.1 Re-unification Cup.

8 teams registered and hence a trial was needed to select 5 teams (one team was reduced by the organiser) to represent HK, and to be entitled to the free accommodation provided.

However, before the trial started, it was announced that individual team might still join the tournament without going for the trial, but they had to bear all expenses. So one team withdrew.

7 Council members were present at that moment and a special meeting was held to discuss the matter. It was decided that teams representing HK must be selected by HKCBA, through trials if necessary.

The Council meeting adopted this decision. It was further agreed that tournament fees for all future trials would be charged on team, rather than individual, basis. The current rate would be \$320 per session .

4.2 The representatives for the Shanghai-HK Interport Tournament would be:

Open Team - AC, DZ, Karic Chiu, Samuel Wan, Nelson Hsi and Terence Tung

Ladies Team - IH, AY, Monica Chan, Shirley Chang, Ella Graca and Lu Qin

4.3 The representatives for the Guangzhou-HK-Macau Interport Tournament would be

Team I - CC, KL Choy, L Lau, LL Lee, T. Ng and HW Wong
Team II - CY, CW, SP Chan, M Yeung, KT Lin and P Poon.

4.4 The following means were proposed in hope to improve the participation rates of regular tournaments.

- The tournament director would announce the event of the next tournament.
- Council members should participate more frequently in regular tournaments.
- Late-comers should be accepted as far as the arrangements made were not affected .
- DZ's secretary would contact all members by phone to get their permission to publish their contact phone numbers in the Bridgzette.
- CC would review the regulations for all special events which required specific entry requirements, e. g. minimum gold points.

- Each Bridgzette issue would include the tournament schedule for the subsequent 3 months.
- AL and AC would start to draft the 1999 tournament schedule.
- After the Intercity event, computer dealt hands would be used as often as possible, with hands records distributed immediately after the event.

5. Date of Next Meeting

It would be held on Wednesday, 12th August 1998 at 6:30 p.m. at the same venue.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.

38th Pacific Asia Bridge Federation Championships

Open Team Captain's Report

Henry Lam

Our open team consisted of seven members. Besides me as the team captain, Samuel Wan paired with Benjamin Kwok, Derek Zen with Peter Chun and Thomas Ng with L.L. Lee. All of them were well experienced players having representing Hong Kong for many times. We reached Kobe on the 14th of May, one day before the tournament.

There were 11 teams participating, playing a double round robin of 20-boards / match with 3 hours allotted per match. The top four teams would qualify for the semifinals (64 boards). China, Chinese Taipei and Indonesia were considered as strong teams and we aimed to compete for the fourth position with New Zealand, Australia and Japan. Since all of our players were experienced players, we intended to let the matches to be shared equally among the players in the first round robin. For the stronger teams Taipei, China and Indonesia, I had placed the more experienced pairs - Samuel Wan - Benjamin Kwok and Derek Zen - Peter Chun to play. Also I had placed Samuel Wan-Benjamin Kwok to face the Australian pair using HUM system.

We had a good start, beating Australia by 20:10. There-after we played quite steadily and were mainly in the fifth position through the first round robin. The leaders after the first round robin were New Zealand and Chinese Taipei with 193 and 190 VPs respectively. We were in the fifth position with 156 VPs, slightly behind China and Indonesia which had 173 and 164 VPs respectively. All our three pairs had positive datums with Derek Zen - Peter Chun +47, Thomas Ng - LL Lee +26 and Samuel Wan - Benjamin Kwok +22.

The hope was high when we entered into the second round robin. With a slight loss to the Philippines and a draw with Macau, we slipped to the sixth position. Thereafter, we performed well, beating Malaysia, Australia and Singapore. This ended the first half of the second round robin. Hope was still high as we were only 15 VPs behind Japan and 10 VPs behind Indonesia which were at the 4th and 5th position respectively. In the second half of the round robin, the first 6 teams would play against each other and if we could beat Indonesia and Japan in the direct matches, our chance for qualification would be high. We had a draw with Indonesia and a slight loss to New Zealand. Our hope for qualification vanished as we lost to China 10:20 and Chinese Taipei 9:21. Our final match was against Japan which we beat them 25:4 and ending at a final

position of 6th.

The final winner of the tournament was China with Indonesia as the first runners up. Ranking third was New Zealand and Chinese Taipei was at the fourth position.

General Masters Individual

在有世界好手 52 人參加的男子個人大師賽中，法國的 Chemla, 波蘭的 Kowalski 分別以 55.23% 及 55.11% 獲得前二名並分別獲得 50,000 及 30,000 法朗的獎金。中國有兩名選手參加，最後得到第 15 名及第 31 名。

比賽方法是：每一名選手必需和其他 51 名選手分別為伴，每一輪 52 人在 13 張桌上打同一副牌。每副牌的頂分為 24 分。叫牌制度均為自然制。在比賽中間，當然不能看自己的叫牌卡，但如果你忘記的話，可以看別人的叫牌卡。基本上大同小異。

比賽的勝負在高手之間主要是叫牌。上一期介紹的挪威選手 Helgemo, 這次運氣不那麼好了。結果只以 50.65% 獲得第 24 名。且看他在第一輪的二副牌，就被 Sharif 以 48:0 擊敗。

52 of the world's top male players participated here. Frenchman Chemla and Pole Kowalski came on Top with 55.23 and 55.11% respectively and won 50,000 and 30,000 French Frances. China had two competitors and achieved only the 15th and 31st positions. In this tournament, each player would partner every others, and in all 13 tables, the same hands were played, 24 points for a top, only natural system were allowed, when the play was on, you could not of course look at your own system card, but in case you forgot something, other's cards might be helpful as all were more or less the same.

At this top level, the winning edge could hinge on the bidding. In the last issue, we said a lot on Norwegian Helgemo, He wasn't so lucky this time, 50.65% and ranked 24th. Here's how he got whitewashed 48:0 in the first 2 boards of 1st round by Omar Sharif:

As North had all along passed, the cashing of this trick could mean a top should west had the CA. On hindsight, the best score for EW would be 3S(X) but would East do so holding his hand? Among HK players, perhaps Patrick Lui would do so, a strict Law of Total Trick convert, 0 hearts against their 8 or 9 spades, if 4H makes, 3S would go plenty down!


